

Got Lawn Moss?

Treat with a premium moss control product such as Bonide Moss Max or Northwest Best Lawn Food with Moss Control. The best time to treat for moss is when the moss is growing actively in late winter or early spring (February, March, April.)

Shortly after application, moss will die and turn black. The dead moss can be removed by raking it out of the lawn. Although unattractive, leaving the dead moss won't hurt.

After the moss has died, apply prilled lime to sweeten the soil and neutralize pH balance. Sweetening the soil helps to retard moss growth.

Use a premium grass seed to fill in any bare spots. Re-seeding will improve the lawn's appearance and will help discourage unwanted moss, weeds or grasses. After reseeding, lay on a 1/8" to 1/4" cover of Northwest Best Top Dressing (approx. 1 cubic foot per 100 square feet.)

Repeat the above process annually in early spring to promote a healthy, beautiful lawn
