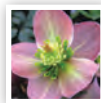

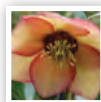

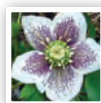
HELLEBORES Watson's has a wonderful selection of the famous winter-blooming Hellebores. Hellebores are attractive evergreen plants that are suitable for any garden. We have many new varieties as well as the tried and true Gold Collection.



MERLIN Has light pink to pink flowers that mature to a deep cranberry, with dark foliage and dark stems. Merlin blooms February through April.



APRICOT BLUSH Part of the Winter Jewels Collection, Apricot Blush has blossoms in shades of white blushed with rosy apricot, and has medium green foliage. Apricot Blush blooms February through March.



SPRING PROMISE™ SERIES This series of Hellebores break all the rules. Uniformly blooming the first year, this flower is offered in a range of straight colors, some with spots and speckles and some frilly with double blossoms.

KETCHUP & MUSTARD This bold and beautiful rose has blooms that are bright red backed by the deepest yellow, and are set atop a rounded shape bush with glossy dark green leaves. This floribunda is tidy enough

to be tucked into the landscape, and also lends itself to be planted in a container.



KOKO LOKO This unusual floribunda rose is the color of a creamy latte, but then goes loco and finishes in a lovely lavender color. Early to bloom, the buds spiral open with amazing form and it does very

well as a cut flower. The plant habit is rounded and bushy and the blooms have a moderate fragrance.



SUGAR MOON White roses exude elegance...but not much in the way of fragrance...until now! This new hybrid tea has an intense sweet citrus and rose fragrance, with big pointed buds of the purest white. The

plant habit is tall and bushy with long flower stems, making Sugar Moon perfect for cutting.



SUNSHINE DAYDREAM An AARS winner, Sunshine Daydream is a grandiflora with light yellow profuse cuplike blooms that finish a creamy yellow. The plant has very glossy dark green leaves

and has excellent disease resistance.
